The New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness (OHSP) is committed to engaging the citizenry of New Jersey as part of the State's homeland security and counter-terrorism efforts.

Accordingly, OHSP has developed a public awareness campaign to encourage New Jersey residents and visitors to report suspicious activity to trained personnel. The *"If You See Something, Say Something"* public awareness campaign has helped OHSP better protect the people and infrastructure of New Jersey.

Building on the *"If You See Something, Say Something"* campaign, we developed a mobile application entitled, **SAFE-NJ.** The **SAFE-NJ App**, enables residents of New Jersey and surrounding States to instantly report suspicious activity from a smartphone or mobile device, which is sent directly to the Counter Terrorism Watch personnel who are on duty 24 hours a day.

The **SAFE-NJ App** is free and is available in iTunes and Google Play.

The SAFE-NJ App enables citizens and visitors to:

- Automatically dial the 1-866-4-SAFE-NJ terrorism tip line
- Enter details about an incident; who, what, when, where, and why
- Capture a photo from the App or use one that already exists on the device
- Automatically find and use the device's location or enter an address
- Report detailed subject and vehicle descriptions
- Include contact information or remain anonymous if preferred

Go to iTunes or Google Play and search for "**SAFE-NJ**". You can download and install the app for free. Please remember that the **SAFE-NJ App** is live and any report submitted will be considered live.
