HEATER CHECKLIST

- Purchase a heater with the seal of an independent testing laboratory.
- Weep the heater at least 3 feet away from anything that can burn, including people.
- Choose a heater with a thermostat and overheat protection.
- **)))** Place the heater on a solid, flat surface.
- Make sure your heater has an auto shut-off to turn the heater off if it tips over.
- Never block an exit.
-))) Keep children away from the space heater.
-))) Plug the heater directly into the wall outlet. Never use an extension cord.
- >>> Space heaters should be turned off and unplugged when you leave the room or go to bed.

Types of electric space heaters

Oil or water-filled radiator

Heated oil or water travels through the heater.

Fan-forced heater


A fan blows warm air over metal coils.

Ceramic heater

Air is warmed over a ceramic heating element.

Infrared heaters

Heat is created by infrared bulbs.
