Please note that, as per the recycling calendar mailed to your home and on-line, all curbside lawn debris collection is complete until mid-October. **NO LAWN DEBRIS MAY BE CURBSIDE** as the Department of Public Works (DPW) begins the summer road program.

Should residents have the need to dispose of lawn debris, we offer the following options:

- Lawn debris may be brought to the Township Recycling Center throughout the year. No permit or fee required. Recycling guidelines and hours can be found on page 10 of the recycling calendar or HERE.
- Picked up and disposed of by private landscapers.
- Some private sanitation haulers will also provide removal service.
- You may hold lawn debris on your property and off the roadway until the next scheduled fall cleanup.

During the summer months, the Department of Public Works (DPW) will be performing street cleaning, road repair and road repaving. For your safety, we remind you that debris in the street interferes with road maintenance, exacerbates flooding and creates a danger for motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists.
