ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Week of August 26, 2019

**** The Department of Public Works (DPW) **EMERGENCY STORM DEBRIS REMOVAL (BRUSH ONLY)** is nearing the end of the **pick up by** Zone. The final collection areas for Zones 6&7 are in process this week. When your street is collected, DPW will not return. Once the emergency collection is complete, no lawn debris may be curbside until the scheduled collection dates beginning in late October. STATE/COUNTY ROAD REPAIRS

ROUTE 520 FROM GORDONS CORNER TO WYNCREST - <u>CLOSED</u> for paving on Wednesday, August 28 from 9am until completion (approximately 4pm). Police will be on site and detours in place. Please avoid the area.

ROUTE 520 AND TENNENT ROAD INTERSECTION - Beginning Wednesday, September 4, state contractors will be on site doing striping and signage in advance of the left-turn signal becoming operational. The project will take approximately a week to complete. Please see prior Road Construction Notice <u>HERE</u> for more.

DUTCH LANE PAVING: On or about August 26 through September 3 the Monmouth County Highway Department will be paving Dutch Lane Road from Colts Neck through Marlboro into Freehold. Paving will take place overnight between the hours of 6pm to 6 am. Detours will be in place as needed and police will be present to assist motorists.

ROADS TO REMAIN OPEN – CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – POLICE PRESENT

The roads will remain open and accessible during construction, although motorists are advised to use caution through the work zone.

Floyd Wycoff Road – Concrete curb repair throughout the week.

Clubhouse Lane, Heron Drive and Teal Court - DPW Milling and Paving throughout the week.

WMUA Sewer Project – The nighttime construction has concluded and they have returned to daytime construction. No road closures are expected. If possible, we suggest that you avoid the area. Final paving on Brandon Road will be scheduled at a later date.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION PREVIEW (MAIN THOROUGHFARES)

Union Hill Road – Last week, the roadway was paved in the vicinity of the commuter lot. Additional paving in the area will commence following Labor Day.

Spring Valley Road – This is a shared services agreement with Old Bridge. Pre-construction meeting complete. Roadwork will begin in September.

Pleasant Valley Road – FEMA Grant awarded August 13, 2019. Work will take approximately 4 months to complete.

Peasley Drive –HUD grant received in the amount of \$120,370 for the resurfacing of Peasley Drive.

Amboy Road – Paving from Tennent Road to new pavement scheduled for fall, 2019.

Harbor Road - Route 79 intersection scheduled for fall, 2019.

Texas Road - Interim pavement repair at the Amboy Road intersection completed. Final paving fall, 2019.

Wooleytown Road (concrete and drainage work completed in April). Paving fall, 2019.
