No roadwork scheduled Monday and Tuesday of this week. Roadwork will commence Wednesday.

PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Marlin Estates and Nolan Road Parks - Removal began of the existing fence and court equipment at both parks. The tennis court and parking lot at Nolan Road Park has been milled, and the new fence has been installed. The same work will begin at Marlin Estates Park. Following, the resurfacing of all courts along with the walkway and parking lot at Nolan Road Park is expected to be completed by the end of next week.

SUBJECT TO ROAD CLOSURES – POLICE PRESENT

Pleasant Valley Road – Construction will begin Wednesday with the installation of mountable concrete curb between Conover Road and Mockingbird Lane. This project is a part of a FEMA Grant awarded August 13, 2019. The work is expected to take approximately 4 months to complete.

ROADS TO REMAIN OPEN – CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – POLICE PRESENT

The roads will remain open and accessible during construction, although motorists are advised to use caution through the work zone.

Annette Drive and Ike Court – Milling and Paving Wednesday and Thursday.

Edie Drive and Jean Court – Milling and Paving Thursday and Friday

Regal Drive, Bond Drive, Jensen Court, and Crescent Court – Milling and paving later this week or early next week.

Monroe Drive, Jackson Way, Hoover Court, Ciafardini Court, York Road, Ingersoll Road, and Ardmore Road - Paving resurfacing (milling/paving) curbing complete. Striping to follow at a later date.

WMUA Sewer Project – The nighttime construction has concluded and they have returned to daytime construction. No road closures are expected. If possible, we suggest that you avoid the area. Final paving on Brandon Road will be scheduled at a later date.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION PREVIEW (MAIN THOROUGHFARES)

Harbor Road – Reconstruction to take place at the intersection of Route 79. (Wooleytown Road, Amboy Road and Texas Road – Paving and striping completed as of Monday afternoon.) Union Hill Road – The roadway was paved in the vicinity of the commuter lot as well as repairs within the lot completed. Additional paving and concrete work on the stairs to the lower level will be scheduled later this fall.

Peasley Drive – HUD grant received in the amount of \$120,370 for the resurfacing of Peasley Drive.
