## **ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Week of October 28, 2019**

Projects are weather dependent and subject to schedule change.

#### **CRINE ROAD CLOSURE TUESDAY AT 9AM**

\*\*\*\*On Tuesday, October 29<sup>th</sup> beginning at 9am, Crine Road will be closed between Station Road and Village Road for paving. The Monmouth County Highway Department will have a detour in place. Please avoid the area and slowdown in construction zones. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Marlin Estates and Nolan Road Parks – The tennis court and parking lot at Nolan Road Park have been resurfaced as have the basketball and tennis courts at Marlin Estates Park. New fencing has been installed around the perimeter of all courts. Additional grading outside the new court and walkway pavement is planned for the coming weeks. Additional improvements include, in part, leveling of new court surfaces, installing tennis, pickleball, and basketball equipment, color coating and striping of new courts.

## SUBJECT TO ROAD CLOSURES - POLICE PRESENT

**Pleasant Valley Road** – Construction will begin Wednesday with the installation of mountable concrete curb between Conover Road and Mockingbird Lane. This project is a part of a FEMA Grant awarded August 13, 2019. The work is expected to take approximately 4 months to complete.

#### **ROADS TO REMAIN OPEN – CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – POLICE PRESENT**

The roads will remain open and accessible during construction, although motorists are advised to use caution through the work zone.

**Topanemus Road** – Monday, October 28 milling and paving between Heron Drive and Julian Way. Striping at a later date.

**Harbor Road** – Originally scheduled for Friday, but rain delayed until today (Monday). Pavement reconstruction approaching the Route 79 intersection.

**Oriel Way –** Roadwork in progress this week.

Milling and Paving completed last week. Striping to follow at a later date: **Reids Hill Road** (between Route 34 and Beacon Hill) and **Pleasant Valley Road** (between Fawns Run and Loredo Drive)

Marlboro Road, Marc Drive, Windham Way – Inlet reconstruction this week.

## ROAD CONSTRUCTION PREVIEW (MAIN THOROUGHFARES)

**Union Hill Road** –Additional paving and concrete work on the stairs to the lower level will be scheduled later this fall.

#### INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER NON-ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

# **STATE PROJECTS:**

**Route 520 and Tennent Road** – NJ DOT traffic signal went live on 9/30/2019. NJDOT is working to resolve technical issues that have caused traffic congestion. NJDOT, Marlboro Township Police and Engineering are monitoring intersection.

**Route 79 Sidewalk Extension** - Project (Route 520 to Wyncrest Road) Ordinance #2019-11 adopted at the 10/3/19 Council Meeting to appropriate an \$875,000.00 grant from the NJDOT Set-Aside Program to fund the project. Township currently coordinating with NJDOT on the design.

**ROUTE 79 NJDOT Road Resurfacing Project** – following intersection improvements are included in the project scheduled for 2021

Tennent Road (CR 3), Lloyd Road, Wyncrest Road, Newman Springs Road (CR 520), School Road East, Route 18 to Ryan Road, Ryan Road & Inverness Drive

**ROUTE 9 and TEXAS ROAD (Old Bridge Township, Middlesex County)** - Traffic signal revisions currently under NJDOT review

**WMUA Sewer Project** on Route 79 - The nighttime construction has concluded and they have returned to daytime construction. No road closures are expected. If possible, we suggest that you avoid the area. Final paving on Brandon Road will be scheduled at a later date.

## **COUNTY PROJECTS:**

The following intersections are being reviewed by County engineers:

- DUTCH LANE ROAD (CR 46) / BUCKLEY ROAD / MOORE ROAD Reconfiguration study
- ROUTE 520 & WYNCREST ROAD Intersection improvements
- ROUTE 520 & CRINE ROAD Traffic Safety review requested
- STATION ROAD (Crine Road to Briarcliff Drive) Construction tentatively planned for 2020.
- **TENNENT ROAD (CR 3) & SPRING VALLEY ROAD** Intersection assessment requested. Temporary striping completed.
