SUBJECT TO ROAD CLOSURES - POLICE PRESENT

Pleasant Valley Road – Construction will begin Wednesday with the installation of mountable concrete curb between Conover Road and Mockingbird Lane. This project is a part of a FEMA Grant awarded August 13, 2019. The work is expected to take approximately 4 months to complete.

Church Road - Road milling and paving to begin on Tuesday through Wednesday. Detours and Police will be in place for <u>road closure for paving on Wednesday.</u>

ROADS TO REMAIN OPEN - CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY - POLICE PRESENT

The roads will remain open and accessible during construction, although motorists are advised to use caution through the work zone.

Wooleytown Road – Following the concrete and drainage work this spring, the road is being milled and paved through Wednesday continuing onto **Harbor Road** at the intersection of Rt.79. **Amboy Road** (between Tennent and Shalom Torah) and **Texas Road** (at the Amboy intersection) will be re-surfaced immediately following. Police on site. Hours of construction 7am until approximately 5pm.

Monroe Drive, Hoover Court, Jackson Way, Ciafardini Court – Through Tuesday, expect concrete work (curb ramp installation, spot curb replacement as necessary) and inlet reconstruction. Re-surfacing of the road to follow in the weeks ahead.

Ardmore Road, York Road, Ingersoll Road - Contractor begins concrete work and inlet reconstruction through Wednesday, 9/18. Re-surfacing to follow in the weeks ahead.

Marlboro Summit (Regal Drive, Bond Drive, Jensen Court, Crescent Court): Concrete work and inlet reconstruction expected to begin on Tuesday and continue through the week. Re-surfacing to follow in the weeks ahead.

Floyd Wycoff Road – Concrete repair and inlet reconstruction is complete and milling and paving underway.

Church Road - Road milling and paving to begin on Tuesday through Wednesday. Detours and Police will be in place for <u>road closure for paving on Wednesday.</u>

Harbor Road – Milling and paving at Route 79 Thursday and Friday.

Clubhouse Lane - DPW Milling and Paving continues.

WMUA Sewer Project – The nighttime construction has concluded and they have returned to daytime construction. No road closures are expected. If possible, we suggest that you avoid the area. Final paving on Brandon Road will be scheduled at a later date.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION PREVIEW (MAIN THOROUGHFARES)

ROUTE 520 AND TENNENT ROAD INTERSECTION – The installation of the ADA required curb ramps is complete. State contractors will return to complete striping and signage in advance of the left-turn signal becoming operational. Please see prior Road Construction Notice <u>HERE</u> for more.

Union Hill Road –The roadway was paved in the vicinity of the commuter lot as well as repairs within the lot completed. Additional paving in the area will be scheduled at night during the coming weeks. **Peasley Drive** –HUD grant received in the amount of \$120,370 for the resurfacing of Peasley Drive.
