STATE/COUNTY ROAD REPAIRS

ROUTE 520 AND TENNENT ROAD INTERSECTION - Beginning Wednesday, September 4, state contractors will be on site doing striping and signage in advance of the left-turn signal becoming operational. The project will take approximately a week to complete. Please see prior Road Construction Notice <u>HERE</u> for more.

ROADS TO REMAIN OPEN – CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – POLICE PRESENT

The roads will remain open and accessible during construction, although motorists are advised to use caution through the work zone.

Spring Valley Road – Milling and paving to begin September 4. Proposed improvements will begin just east of Route 9 in Old Bridge and end at Tennent Road in Marlboro. Milling operations will commence on September 4 beginning in Old Bridge, and into Marlboro by September 5. Paving operations will than commence and continue into the following week.

New concrete curb has been installed on **Church Road between Tennent and Floyd Wycoff**, along with new curb ramps at the intersections of **Timber Hill and Halifax**. Concrete curb and gutter replacement on **Floyd Wycoff Road** will continue into next week, expected to conclude by Wednesday. The contractor will remain in the area on **Bruce Road** installing approximately 200' of underdrain with new curb and gutter curb and gutter on both sides of the street (approx. 400' total) at the Prince Edward end.

Clubhouse Lane - DPW Milling and Paving throughout the week.

WMUA Sewer Project – The nighttime construction has concluded and they have returned to daytime construction. No road closures are expected. If possible, we suggest that you avoid the area. Final paving on Brandon Road will be scheduled at a later date.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION PREVIEW (MAIN THOROUGHFARES)

Union Hill Road – The roadway was paved in the vicinity of the commuter lot as well as repairs within the lot completed. Additional paving in the area will be scheduled at night during the coming weeks. **Pleasant Valley Road –** FEMA Grant awarded August 13, 2019. Work will take approximately 4 months to complete.

Peasley Drive –HUD grant received in the amount of \$120,370 for the resurfacing of Peasley Drive. **Amboy Road** – Paving from Tennent Road to new pavement scheduled for fall, 2019.

Harbor Road - Route 79 intersection scheduled for fall, 2019.

Texas Road - Interim pavement repair at the Amboy Road intersection completed. Final paving to be scheduled fall, 2019.

Wooleytown Road (concrete and drainage work completed in April). Paving to begin on or about week of September 9.
