

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the previously noticed 2020 public meetings of the Planning Board for the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth, New Jersey will be changed to occur remotely rather than in-person on the following days: Wednesday, May 6, Wednesday, May 20, Wednesday, June 3 and Wednesday, June 17, 2020. The meetings will all begin at 7:30 pm.

Anyone who wishes to comment on an application before the Board may do so by contacting the Department of Community Development on or before 12:00 pm two days before the meeting at 732 536-0200 x1808. By way of example, for the May 6, 2020 meeting you must contact the Township by 12:00 pm on May 4, 2020. You will be asked to provide your name, address, email address and phone number, identify the meeting date, and the application(s) you wish to comment on and whether you will have any exhibits to display. Exhibits must be labelled with your name, the name of the application(s), be pre-numbered, and provided in a digital format. If you are directed to voicemail, please leave the information referenced above. You will later receive emails from Webex with instructions to complete your registration and to join the meeting. Note, use the links in the email receive to join the meeting as a commenter. Upon joining, your microphone will be muted. At the appropriate point in the meeting, you will be unmuted by the meeting host so that you may comment.

The individual Planning Board meeting dial-in phone numbers and meeting ids with links to join the meetings will be posted on the Township web site (link below). In order to attend, follow the directions provided to register and join the meeting, pressing # when indicated. It is recommended that you join the meeting 5-10 minutes prior to meeting start time.
