WHEREAS, when awarding such contracts, the Business Administrator shall be obligated to adhere to all applicable provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, including N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6.1 requiring that, if practicable, at least two competitive quotations must be solicited for all contracts that are less than the bid threshold, but 15% or more of that amount; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council believes that providing such authorization to the Business Administrator will allow the business of the Township to proceed in the most efficient manner, while at the same time, allowing the Business Administrator to ensure that the process by which all contracts under \$25,000 are awarded complies with the applicable requirements and the intent of the Local Public Contracts Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro in the County of Monmouth that the Business Administrator, is hereby authorized to execute and approve any and all contracts up to \$25,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Administrator, when awarding such contracts, is obligated to adhere to all applicable provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, including N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6.1 requiring that, if practicable, at least two competitive quotations must be solicited for all contracts that are less than the bid threshold, but 15% or more of that amount; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Administrator, is authorized, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6.1, to award contracts that are less that 15% of the bid threshold without soliciting competitive quotations; and

## RESOLUTION #2015-51

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TAX ASSESSOR TO PERFORM VARIOUS DUTIES ASSOCIATED WITH HER POSITION

WHEREAS, statutory provision is made for the review and correction of errors by the local Tax Assessor prior to certification of an assessment list; and

WHEREAS, statutory provision is also made for the discovery and correction of errors by the local Tax Assessor during the establishment of the tax rate; and

WHEREAS, changes in the property ownership at times necessitates adjustments in the Veterans and/or Senior Citizen deductions allowed on the assessment list; and

WHEREAS, responsibility for maintenance and correction of the assessment list rests with the local Tax Assessor subject to laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, in certain instances outlined in N.J.S.A. 54:3-21, taxpayers and taxing districts are authorized to file appeals to the county board of taxation or, if the statutory requirements are satisfied, to file a complaint directly with the Tax Court; and

WHEREAS, in the case of an appeal or complaint filed by a taxpayer, the taxing district may file a cross petition of appeal or counterclaim; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council now desires to authorize the Tax Assessor to perform certain duties associated with her position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro that, in addition to those powers given to the Tax Assessor by statute, the Tax Assessor may authorize the filing with the Monmouth County Board of Taxation or Tax Court such appeals or complaints as may be necessary to maintain the accuracy and equality in the assessment list of the Township of Marlboro, in accordance with the procedures set forth by the applicable statutory provisions

and/or approved by the New Jersey Division of Taxation and/or the New Jersey Attorney General's Office; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Assessor is hereby authorized to file complaints on behalf of the Township of Marlboro based upon farmland and rollback procedures; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, with respect to appeals or complaints filed by a taxpayer with the Monmouth County Board of Taxation or Tax Court, the Tax Assessor may authorize the filing of cross petitions of appeal and counterclaims; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Assessor is authorized to negotiate settlements of appeals or complaints filed with the Monmouth County Board of Taxation or the Tax Court and to authorize settlements of such appeals without obtaining Township Council's approval in the event the settlement involves \$17,500 or less per parcel per tax year on behalf of the Township of Marlboro.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO TO ENTER INTO INSTALLMENT PAYMENT AGREEMENTS FOR PROPERTY TAX ARREARS AND DELINQUENT WATER CHARGES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:5-19 authorizes installment payment agreements for property tax arrears and other charges which would be a lien against real property such as delinquent water charges; and

WHEREAS, the installment payment agreements must provide payments large enough to pay back the tax arrears or delinquent charges and must require that all taxes or other charges are kept current as they come due; and

WHEREAS, the installment payment agreements must be reduced to a written agreement signed by the property owner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro that it hereby grants its authority to Kelly A. Hahn, the Tax Collector of the Township of Marlboro to enter into installment payment agreements for tax arrears and delinquent water charges in the case of hardships in an amount not to exceed One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars and said installment payment agreements are to provide that all taxes or other charges are to be kept current as they become due and shall require prompt payments of the installment payments agreed to; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has calculated that the rate to be charged for such special inspections outside of the normal business hours and days of operation is \$85.00 per hour for a Sub-Code Official and \$70.00 per hour for an Inspector; and

WHEREAS, the rate to be charged for such special inspections outside of the normal business hours and days of operation of the Township shall be charged at a minimum of two hours per discipline times the applicable rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the fees to be charged for inspections performed by the Department of Community Development outside of the normal business hours and days of operation of the Township of Marlboro shall be \$85.00 per hour for a Sub-Code Official and \$70.00 per hour for an Inspector with a minimum charge of two hours per discipline for such special inspections; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be provided to each of the following:

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO TOWN COUNCIL AUTHORIZING A SUBORDINATION OF A MORTGAGE DATED MARCH 17, 2011, ON A PROPERTY LOCATED AT 11 PRESCOTT DRIVE, MARLBORO, NEW JERSEY, AND OWNED BY GAETANO IGNARRA AND PAULA HEALY-IGNARRA H/W

WHEREAS, the Township of Marlboro has implemented a housing rehabilitation program in the Township, which was administered in accordance with the New Jersey's Fair Housing Act (N.J.S.A. 52:27D-301 et. seq.) and the administrative rules of the Council on Affordable Housing n/k/a The Office Of Local Planning Services; and

WHEREAS, as part of the foregoing rehabilitation program Marlboro has in fact provided rehabilitation assistance to various residents of The Township of Marlboro; and

WHEREAS, on or about December 13, 2008, the homeowners hereunder, Gaetano Ignarra and Paula Healy-Ignarra ("the Homeowners"), purchased a residence at 11 Prescott Drive in the Township of Marlboro, Block 232, Lot 5 ("the Residence") with said deed being recorded on December 16, 2008, in the Monmouth County Clerk's Office in deed book OR-8750, at page 221 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Homeowners had subsequently made application to Marlboro Township's rehabilitation program and they qualified for a loan in order to correct code violations and to correct substandard conditions at the Residence in furtherance of Marlboro's rehabilitation program; and

WHEREAS, the stated repairs had been made to the Residence in compliance with the rehabilitation program's dictates; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of approval into the rehabilitation program Marlboro Township held (and continues to hold) a mortgage in the amount of \$17,890.00 regarding the Residence ("the Marlboro Mortgage") with said mortgage (dated March 17, 2011) being recorded in the Monmouth County Clerk's Office on July 5, 2011, in deed book OR-8897 at page 3182; and

WHEREAS, the Homeowners now desire to refinance an existing mortgage (not the Marlboro Mortgage) with Guaranteed Rate, Inc. and as part and parcel of same, a subordination of the Marlboro Mortgage is sought; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Marlboro previously granted a request to subordinate by the Homeowners on August 14, 2014, as per Resolution No. 2014-296 under which the Marlboro Mortgage would be subordinated in favor of a refinance from Guaranteed Rate in the amount of \$180,000; and

WHEREAS, Guaranteed Rate never completed the aforementioned refinance nor recorded the executed subordination agreement provided by Marlboro; and

WHEREAS, Guaranteed Rate is now prepared to move forward with the refinance for the Homeowners however, the amount of the loan has increased to \$200,000 and as a result of the foregoing Guaranteed Rate, Inc. and the Homeowners have requested that the Township of Marlboro amend its prior subordination agreement to reflect the higher amount being refinanced; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is good cause to grant this subordination of the Marlboro Mortgage and amend the prior subordination from August 14, 2014, which was never recorded;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Hon. Mayor Jonathan L. Hornik is hereby authorized to execute the attached subordination of the Marlboro Mortgage on the Residence; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that subsequent to the signature of the said subordination that this subordination will be recorded in the Monmouth County Clerk's Office.
