#### MARLBORO TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING

August 11, 2016

WHEREAS, Freehold has agreed to provide the Code Enforcement and Housing/Building Inspection Services on an asneeded basis to Marlboro; and

WHEREAS, Freehold and Marlboro desire to enter into a Shared Services Agreement to set forth the operational and financial terms concerning the work to be performed; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Marlboro as follows:

WHEREAS, the Township is in need of professional engineering services in connection with the aboveground diesel fuel storage tank removal and replacement ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, CME Associates has provided a proposal dated August 4, 2016 (the "Proposal") for the professional services required in connection with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Marlboro and CME Associates have entered into a Professional Services Contract, awarded under a fair and open process, and seeks to amend such Contract to expand the scope of services to include the Professional Services (as defined hereinabove) for the Project at a fee not to exceed \$33,000.00 for such Professional Services, as further described and set forth in CME's Proposal, attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the value of the Professional Services Contract will exceed \$17,500.00 in the aggregate; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the Township of Marlboro to amend its contract with CME Associates to provide the required additional Professional Services for the Project in accordance with the Proposal; and
