LEGISLATIVE MINUTES

MARLBORO TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING

September 6, 2018

The Marlboro Township Council held its regularly scheduled Meeting on September 6, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. at the Marlboro Municipal Complex, 1979 Township Drive, Marlboro, New Jersey.
